I go to the Sangha for refuge.










The Law of Karma

8. Right Meditation.

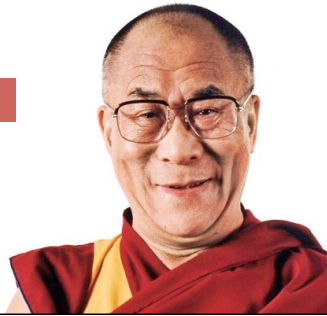

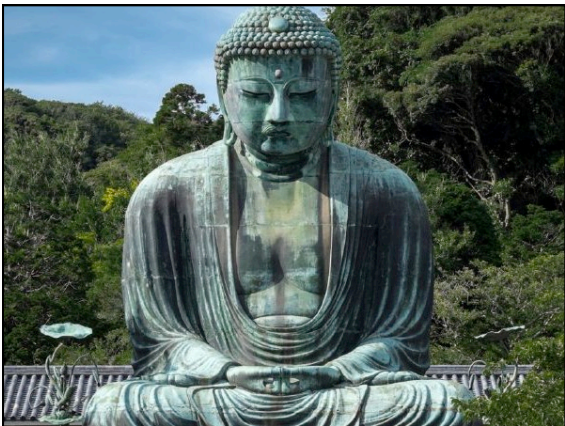






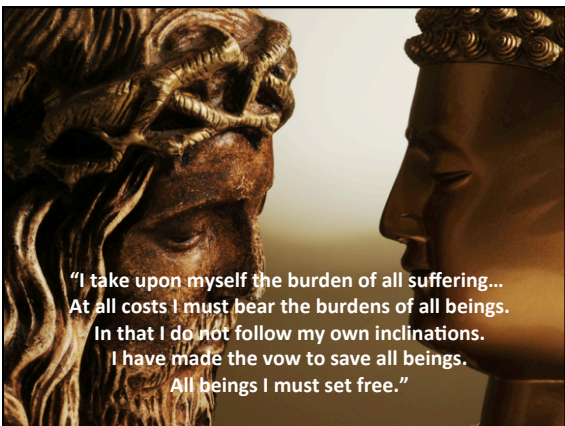
